Diploma in Hotel Management

Students enrolled in the Diploma of Hotel Management course are trained in all fields of hotel operations, focusing on core functional fields such as hotel operations, concierge, meeting management, event preparation, and wedding services.

Students learn how to handle the hotel room division, how to arrange conventions and activities, how to offer appropriate guest facilities, and how to prepare and conduct from the supervision stage to the preparation of events and weddings.

The hotel business is a vital part of the hospitality industry. Students are trained in various services relating to hospitality, such as VIP Services, the organization of food courts, and fitness exhibits for leadership and marketing skills development.
